


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
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

# Process vs. Method

One of the greatest dangers we face today in church growth is making methods supreme

Methods used in the <u>fastest</u> <u>growing</u>

<u>church</u> in your area may not work in

your <u>church</u>

but God's <u>principles</u> of church growth will work in <u>every</u> <u>church</u>.

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#### Process vs. Method

Before we can implement methods, we must understand the <a href="process">process</a> God uses to redeem the world through the witness of the church. Church growth is a leading topic today. The population of the world is growing every second while some \_\_\_\_\_ and denominations are plateauting or declining at an Alarming rate

Still, we must not become so preoccupied with the search for the Right method to reach an exploding population of <a href="Lost">Lost</a> people that we forget that an understanding of God's <u>principles</u> for kingdom growth is primary.

# Growth Begins With Divine Process

Methods of church growth are <u>important</u>, but God does not begin with <u>methods</u>.

He begins with a <u>Divine process</u>, and we must begin <u>where</u> He begins.

Somehow in our rush to find methods, we have forgotten that the <u>kingdom</u> of <u>God</u>, <u>announced</u> by <u>Christ</u> at the beginning of <u>His</u> <u>ministry</u> (Mark 1:14-15), is a <u>reality</u> in our world.

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That kingdom is energized by <u>God Himself</u>.

The Bible frequently <u>refers</u> to <u>God's kingdom</u> as the <u>outworking</u> of His plan of <u>World redemption</u>.

Scripture reveals God consistently doing two things: creating and redeeming.

He chose to create <a href="humanity">humanity</a> in His <a href="image">image</a> to have <a href="fellowship">fellowship</a> with <a href="him">Him</a> and with <a href="One">One</a> another</a>.

God chose to create every <u>person</u> with a <u>will</u> by which <u>he</u> or <u>she accepts</u> or <u>rejects</u> <u>Him</u>.

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Scripture shows <u>Adam</u> and <u>Eve</u> turning away from God in <u>disobedience</u> and <u>losing</u> the opportunity to <u>fellowship</u> with <u>Him</u>.

## God Chose To Redeem

In spite of our <u>sin</u>, God chose to <u>redeem</u> a people for <u>Himself</u> out of the <u>world</u>.

Redemption restores the benefits lost in the fall and provides the redeemed with fellowship

with God and One another.

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## God Chose To Redeem

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When Jesus came to earth, He brought <a href="mailto:salvation">salvation</a> to persons who were <a href="mailto:ln">ln</a> sin</a> and <a href="mailto:Separated">Separated</a> from God.

He came <a href="mailto:preaching">preaching</a> the good news of the <a href="mailto:kingdom">kingdom</a> and <a href="mailto:urging">urging</a> people to <a href="mailto:Repent">Repent</a> of <a href="mailto:Their">Their</a> sins</a> and <a href="mailto:Trust">Trust</a> in <a href="mailto:Him">Him</a>.

## The Kingdom Continues To Grow

The Bible declares that the kingdom of God is growing and cannot Be stopped.

The knowledge that the Lord is working today, as He did in times past, to bring persons into His kingdom brings hope and joy to every Christian.

Even though some churches and denominations are plateauing and declining, we need to remember that God still is at work in <a href="His Kingdom">His World</a> and that <a href="His Kingdom">His Growing</a>.

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
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Jesus Himself gives us this assurance

#### God Chose To Redeem

It's like a mustard seed that a man took and sowed in his own garden. It grew and became a tree, and the birds of the sky nested in its branches. 'And again He said, "To what should I compare the kingdom of God? It's like yeast that a woman took and mixed into 50 pounds of flower until it spread through the entire mixture. Luke 13:18-21



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#### God Chose To Redeem

The failure of <u>people</u> or <u>nations</u> to <u>respond</u> to God does not <u>invalidate</u> for a moment the <u>Eternal\_truth</u> about the <u>growth</u> of God's kingdom.

Christ explained that He <u>inaugurated</u> the <u>kingdom</u> of God among <u>humanity</u> when He began <u>His</u> <u>ministry</u>.

God's kingdom was in <u>progress</u> then and has been in <u>progress</u> ever since.

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## God Chose To Redeem

Jesus knew the kingdom would grow despite opposition, lack of faith, Personal failures, and many other problems.

We discover the secret of Kingdom growth and development from God's Word, from history, and from a careful examination of our present circumstances

## The Beginning Place For Growth

We need to begin where God begins. Our Lord set Church growth in the arena of the Kingdom of God.

Within the <u>context</u>of the <u>kingdom</u>, we are able to <u>understand</u> that church growth <u>can</u> and <u>will</u> occur.

Church growth is the result of God's Supernatural work through His people to accomplish His kingdom's Purposes.

Church growth also is the <u>result</u> of God's people <u>obeying</u> His will and His <u>Word</u> in the <u>World</u>

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My prayer is that the kingdom principles of church growth will become your <u>guiding</u> principles and that as You/we and Your / our church apply them, You/we will experience church growth as our Lord intended.
